What is Genie Lift Pro™ machine specific operator training?

Genie Lift Pro™ Operator Training Courses are Verification of Competency (VOC) high quality, professional-grade, programs that are delivered through a network of certified trainers and are designed to satisfy the general training requirements for elevated work platforms as defined by Genie the manufacturer.

The courses are specific to Genie Elevated Work Platform's (EWP) and have been developed to provide standardised training on Genie products thus creating a benchmark. The programs incorporate current adult learning theory and consist of detailed graphics, hands on training and a variety of practical theory tests that provide a rich and interactive learning environment for the trainee.

Is Genie Lift Pro™ Verification of Competency (VOC) training?

Yes. Our assessment is aligned with the EWPA VOC assessment guidelines. We have partnered with Registered Training Organization (RTO) Workplace Training Center. All trainers delivering Genie Lift Pro™ are qualified Certificate IV and work safe accredited trainers who are linked to the RTO.

What are the benefits to the operator?

On completion of a Genie Lift Pro™ training course the operator will have the knowledge and understanding of the specific features, inbuilt safety controls and operational controls of the Genie EWP model based on a grouping of scissor lift and boom families. The operator retains the Genie Lift Pro™ qualification which is valid for 2 years.

What machine families are available?

Genie has grouped the machines into families as there are commonalities in the operation of these machines. For example the operator can do training on the SL family and be verified as competent to operate the following Genie scissor lifts GS™-1530, GS-1532, GS-1930, GS-1932, GS-2032, GS-2632, GS-2046, GS-2646, GS-3246, GS-4047 scissor lifts.

What do operators need to complete the program?

Minimum requirement to complete Genie Lift Pro™ training are

- Scissor lift operators will require a yellow card
- and Boom lift operators will require a high risk licence.

How does it compare to existing operator training programs?

The majority of the training programs being offered today by legitimate training providers serve their purpose of increasing operator safety in the industry; an activity that we strongly support and encourage.

Genie Lift Pro™ training has been developed by the manufacturer to provide standardised training on Genie products thus creating a benchmark.

Why was Genie Lift Pro™ training developed?

- To provide standardised formal training from the manufacturer on Genie products
- There has been an increase in the demand of machine specific training over the last 3 years
- To assist construction companies who are creating training programs for their team members to cover the key issues in relation to the Genie products
- A requirement was identified for enhanced manufacturer training on the operation on Genie products in the Australian market

How does it work?

- Book a training session and meet the assessment criteria by completing the theory component and demonstrating correct use of the specific Genie product
- The certified Genie assessor will issue a temporary operator card with Genie issuing a full version within three weeks of the assessment

How much will it cost?

How long does it take to complete Genie Lift Pro™ training?

Genie Lift Pro™ training is divided into two sections

- A theory component which is classroom based and takes one hour to complete.
- A standard practical assessment which takes three hours to complete.

N.B. Practical assessment is flexible on the number of machine families that can be completed during the three hours. A combination of up to four from SL, SLS, RT, S, and Z families can be completed during practical assessment. SU and ZU families each require three hours to complete the practical assessment.

How many people can do Genie Lift Pro™ training at a time?

5 to 16 people can be trained at one time depending on the number of machine families selected.

- 10 people can complete a full day training on four families selected from the SL, SLS, RT, S and Z categories
- 12 people can complete a full day training on either SU or ZU categories

What happens if an operator loses their training card?

Genie maintains a database of operators who have completed the Genie Lift Pro™ training courses. A replacement card can easily be ordered from Genie. If immediate confirmation of VOC is required Genie can confirm via a phone call which courses the operator has completed.
